Licia Canton is the author of *Almond Wine and Fertility* (2008) – short stories for women and their men – soon-to-be published in Italian. She is also a literary critic and translator, and the editor-in-chief of *Accenti* – the Canadian magazine for lovers of all things Italian. Her stories and essays have appeared in anthologies and journals. She has been a guest speaker in universities and literary events in Canada, Italy, France, Hungary, the United Kingdom, and the United States. As editor she has published several collections of creative and critical writing – *The Dynamics of Cultural Exchange*, *Adjacencies: Minority Writing in Canada*, *Writing Beyond History*, *Reflections on Culture and Writing Our Way Home* – as well as two volumes on the internment of Italian Canadians. She has served on the jury of the Strega-Blue Metropolis Prize. A member of the Writers’ Union of Canada, she has served on the board of the Quebec

Writers’ Federation and is currently President of the Association of Italian Canadian Writers. She holds a Ph.D. from Université de Montréal and a Master's from McGill University. She lives in Montreal with her husband and three children.
