Wang Fang, who writes under the pseudonym **Fang Fang**, was born in 1955 in Nanjing. She began writing and publishing poetry in her early twenties. In 1982, she published her first short story, “On the Big Caravan,” and since has published several novels, collections of novellas and short stories.

In 1987, Fang Fang published the novella *Landscape* and won the National Literary Award for Novellas. This story was regarded as opening an era for Neo-realism in Chinese Modern Literature, and has been translated into English and French. She has recently published stories about wars. Her latest novel, *Wuchang Wall* (2011), originates in the history of Wuchang, a city known for the great revolution in 1911 that helped to found China.

Fang Fang is the president of Chinese Writers Association of Hubei Province.
